COMMUNITY GRANTS

The Shire of Strathbogie Grants scheme is open for 2013/14.



The Community Matching Grants (up to \$5000) and Events Grants (\$3000 for oneoff or inaugural events and \$2000 for ongoing events) will close on Friday 5 July at 5.00pm. Other grants include Quick Response Grants (up to \$1000), Streets of Initiative Grants (up to \$1000) and Under 18's Grants (Junior Youth up to \$100 and Senior Youth up to \$300); these are all accepted any time of the year but are assessed on a monthly basis. The William Pearson Bequest (in total \$2500) is solely for projects or events based in Euroa that are for the benefit of children's playgrounds, parks and gardens, the Euroa Citizen's Band or for the beautification of the town. These are assessed once per year, the closing date is Friday 5 July at 5.00pm. For further information contact Robbie Rae, Community Development Officer on 1800 065 993.

STRATHBOGIE SHIRE GOES GREEN

Following the success of the kerbside green organics collection trial in Euroa in 2012, Strathbogie Shire Council is offering ratepayers within the township areas of Violet Town, Euroa and Nagambie an opportunity to take up a green organics collection service on an ongoing basis.

Council is offering the fortnightly collection service to households within the above townships at a cost of \$85 per annum per property. Those taking part in the green organics collection service will receive a \$20 discount on the annual garbage collection costs listed on their rates notices. The service will introduce a third bin for disposal of food scraps and garden waste for composting.



A minimum of 1500 interested ratepayers are required for the collection to go ahead. Don't miss this opportunity to reduce our landfill and help the environment by going green.
