The Opera Scholars are coming to town on Sunday 22 October at 2pm for an entertaining afternoon of song at the Euroa Community Cinema.

The Opera Scholars are a not for profit organisation that foster the vocal development of young classical singers aged 18-28.

Seniors can also enjoy free travel on V/Line Economy Class rail and coach between 8-15 October by showing their Victorian Seniors Card.

Seniors can also call into the Euroa, Nagambie and Violet Town libraries during the month of October to access large print books, books on CD, music CDs, DVD's, newspapers and magazines available to read on-site or for loan.
