What happens to your landfill waste after it has been collected?

After your red lidded bin has been emptied, the waste material is transported to the Benalla Landfill, where it is confined, compacted and buried in in the ground in highly engineered cells. Due to the efforts required to minimise the environmental impacts of landfills, the cost to dispose of waste is significantly high and ever increasing.
