- Only CASH or CHEQUE payments can be made at all Resource Recovery Centres. A receipt will be issued by the site operator
- Domestic volumes (up to 2m³) of household recyclable items such as glass containers, aluminium cans, paper, cardboard, steel cans etc are accepted <u>free of charge</u> at the locations highlighted above. Charges apply for larger volumes.
- Large salvageable metal items such as old water tanks, fencing wire, roofing iron, etc may be deposited <u>free of</u> <u>charge</u> at the Violet Town, Euroa, Nagambie and Avenel Resource Recovery Centres.
- Green waste may be deposited at the appropriate sites for the standard tipping fee. This material is mulched on site and mulch made available free of charge for residents.
- If mulched green waste is required by ratepayers, it must be self loaded and taken at their own risk. The mulch quality varies from time to time and is not guaranteed by Council.
- Whitegoods such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc may be taken to the Euroa, Nagambie and Violet Town Resource Recovery Centres. A fee is charged for items requiring degassing.
- Computers (including all computer components eg: printers, keyboards, mouses, copiers etc.) and televisions
 are accepted at Violet Town, Euroa, Nagambie and Avenel Resource Recovery Centres <u>free of charge</u> to be
 recycled.
- Chemical or liquid substances(except automotive oil) are not accepted. For hazardous materials, contact Chemclear 1800 008 182 or <u>www.chemclear.com.au</u>. For paint, contact Shepparton Transfer Station, Wanganui Road, Shepparton, Ph. 5832 9700.
