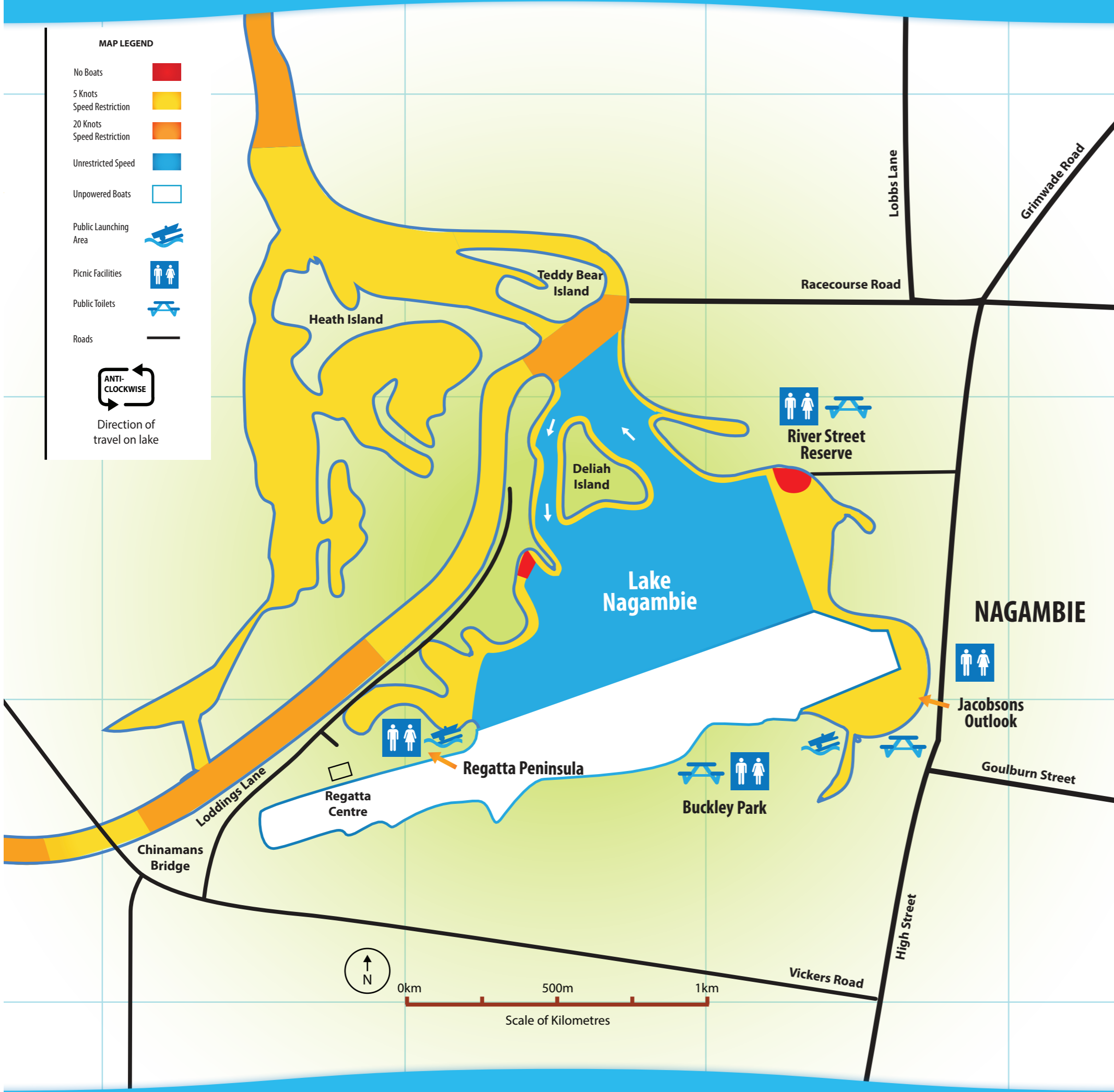


MAP LEGEND
