## What is a rates holiday?

It is a fantastic new initiative that provides first home buyers (who are eligible for the State Government First Home Owners Grant of \$20,000) a two-year rates free period for both the general rate and municipal charge. This rates holiday aims to attract new residents and grow our Shire population.

An example of how this will benefit first home buyers looks like this...

**Property Value \$300,000 + Rates Holiday =  
Approx. \$3,700 savings over a two year period.**

## Tourism, Arts & Culture



Some of the feedback from our Conversation Cafes highlighted that our residents wanted to see a greater focus on developing tourism, arts and culture opportunities within the Shire.

We are certainly listening and our first item of business in this area – we have established a dedicated sub-committee and will be employing a Tourism, Arts and Culture Officer who will also manage and promote our grants programs.

This is a great step forward and we certainly look forward to seeing this space grow and develop.

## Zero to One Roads

**Did you know that the Strathbogieshires maintains one of the largest road networks in regional Victoria?**

Our Zero to One Roads Program will target some of our least maintained roads in the Shire (Class Zero), with the aim of improving their overall maintenance to bring them up a level in our maintenance program (Class One).

We will provide priority works on roads to market and roads with higher levels of residents.

What does this equate to? Over 60 roads in 2017/18 will receive drainage, gravel spreading and general grading work to improve their overall standard.






**Total cost: \$400k | Total kilometres: Over 60km**



## Capital Works – At a Glance

**Capital Works Budget = \$14.5m**

This includes an investment of:

-  **\$400,000** works to some of our least maintained roads (Zero to One Roads Program)
-  **\$300,000** on footpaths and walking trails
-  **\$1.3m** on drainage works
-  **\$9.5m** on road and bridge maintenance
-  **33.6km** in road upgrades

# Continuing the War on Waste

Did you know in Australia alone our waste is growing at double the rate of our population?

Yes it's true. Australia generates over 52 million tonnes of waste a year. Australia is ranked 5th highest for generating the most municipal waste in the world.

This is a damning statistic that the Strathbogie Shire takes very seriously. Thankfully there are many things we can do as a community to reduce this figure:



Council will investigate opportunities to reduce single use plastic bags and bottles in the Strathbogie Shire.



Continue to support the Organics Waste Kerbside Collection that has already collected over 1,315 tonnes in 2016-2017.

*This is an increase of approximately 25% from the previous year!*



Ongoing promotion of our three bin system to improve community understanding of exactly what can go into each bin.



## Sustainable Strathbogie 2030

Sounds serious doesn't it? Well here at Council we take sustainability very seriously. So much so we are developing a plan to address sustainable living into and beyond the next decade. It includes important items such as:

- Reducing emissions and waste
- Bogie Bulk Buy (solar scheme)
- Environmentally sustainable land use planning
- Partnerships to reduce single use plastics consumption
- Continued support for roadside weed and pest program
- Roadside conservation
