Summary

Council at its Ordinary Meeting held on December 15, 2015 resolved to give public notice of its intention to declare a Special Charge for the construction of drainage and road widening of Rowe Street, Euroa.

The notice invited submissions under Section 163(A), 163(B) and 223 of the Local Government Act 1989 (The Act).

RECOMMENDATION

That Council resolve to:

- 1. Receive and note the submissions in response to the public notice of the intention to declare a Special Charge in Rowe Street.**
- 2. Formally consider all received submissions and determine the outcome of the intention to declare the Special Charge at a Special Council meeting to be held Tuesday February 23, 2016 commencing at 5.00pm at the Euroa Community Conference Centre.**

Background

Council directed that public notice of the intention to declare a Special Charge be given in the Euroa Gazette and the Age. The dates of publication were

Euroa Gazette	23/12/2015
Age	19/12/2015

Council also directed that separate letters enclosing a copy of the notice be sent to the owners of properties within the Special Charge area. An advance copy of the notice was forwarded on 16/12/2015 and follow up copies of the actual advertisement were sent on December 22, 2015.

The advertisement advised that:

Any person may make a written submission to the Council under sections 163A and 223 of the Act.

In addition, any person who will be required to pay the Special Charge to be imposed by the proposed declaration has a right to object to the proposed declaration and may also make a written objection to the Council under section 163B of the Act.

Submissions

Two letters of objection have been received. Both letters make reference to Section 163B(1) of the Act but provide no information on the basis of the objections. Copies of the letters have been provided to Councillors. Both submitters have requested to be heard.

The submitters are not known to be landowners within the Special Charge area.

Alternative Options

The objections are being treated as section 223 submissions, as invited, and need to be received and heard at the meeting as advertised.
