Nagambie Angle Parking Project completed

Strathbogie Shire Council would like to thank local businesses and the wider public for their ongoing patience while the Nagambie Angle Parking Project was underway and is pleased to announce the works have now been completed.

Strathbogie Shire Mayor Amanda McClaren thanked the community for their involvement in the extensive consultation process and for their patience during the planning and implementation phases of the project.

"We'd like to thank our community for their ongoing patience and remind the public to be aware of the changed conditions, particularly the speed limit from 50km per hour to 40km per hour in the shopping precinct," Cr McClaren explained.

"One of the other significant traffic changes associated with the angle parking is that Marie Street has become a one-way street through the centre median area.

Marie Street becoming one-way in this section was a decision of VicRoads to improve traffic flow due to there now being only a single traffic lane in both north and south bound directions," Cr McClaren explained.

The new line marking has made way for angle parking from the Goulburn Street roundabout to the Vale Street intersection, leaving parallel parking unchanged on the centre median strip side of High Street both north and south bound.

The single traffic lane in both north and south bound directions has provided the old left traffic lane space for motorists to safely reverse out of the car parks and to merge into the traffic lane.

The project has created an additional 20 parking spaces on High Street, including more disabled parking.

Road signage reminding oncoming traffic of changed conditions will remain in place for another week to give road users more time to adapt to these changes.
