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THE PROBLEM

Nagambie is a popular seasonal holiday destination located in the Strathbogie Shire 125 kilometres north of Melbourne. The town is well known for its fresh water lake and surrounding 40 kilometres of Goulburn River waterways and the Goulburn Weir.

Nagambie Lakes Regatta Centre is one of Victoria's premier water sport facilities, holding over 20 major events and competitions each year, with its largest rowing event, The APS Heads of the River, attracting up to 17,000 people to the region. The lake has become stagnant in its ability to attract further prominent events and competitions due to a number of infrastructure deficiencies.

THE SOLUTION

Council needs your support to deliver several catalytic tourism infrastructure projects which will position Nagambie Lakes Regatta Centre as an International Water Sports Centre of Excellence.

These upgrades will cement Nagambie's reputation as a destination for national and international water sports and events.
