The author of this report and officers/contractors providing advice in relation to this report do not have a direct or indirect interest, as provided in accordance with the *Local Government Act 1989*.

#### Summary

Further to Council's decision of 13 November 2017 to commence the statutory process to reappoint the current Chief Executive Officer (CEO) without advertising the position; it is recommended to reappoint Mr Steven Mark Crawcour (the current CEO) until the 19 November 2019 at the expiry of his current contract. This is consistent with the resolution that the reappointment is no longer than 18 months from the completion of the current contract. Additionally, no further extensions are recommended.

It is also proposed to commence the recruitment process for a new CEO in December of this year to allow sufficient time for the Councillors to engage the right recruitment specialist and map out the most appropriate process.

If the recommendation is passed, the proposed total remuneration under the contract must be made available for public inspection within 14 days of the resolution.

- B) That the Strathbogie Shire Council commence discussions with the current CEO Steven Mark Crawcour in relation to contract term and conditions.

The meeting was reconvened twice to 13 November 2017, where the motion was put and carried, 4 votes (for) to 2 votes (against).
