Summary

Due to the absence of the Mayor and Deputy Mayo, Council is required to nominate a substitute Councillor to represent the Council at the 15 May 2015 Municipal Association of Victoria (MAV) State Council Meeting of all Councils in Victoria. It is essential that Council is represented at this meeting as it will have two Resolutions put to the meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

That Council nominates Councillor Malcolm Little to be the substitute representative of this Council at the MAV State Council Meeting on the 15 May 2015.

Background

The Mayor, as the MAV delegate, and Deputy Mayor, as the normal substitute, are unable to attend the 15 May 2015 MAV State Council Meeting due to prior commitments. As such, Council is required to nominate a substitute Councillor to attend on its behalf. Therefore a formal Council report with resolution of Council is required as per the attached nomination form.

The MAV holds two State Council Meetings each year, in May and October where all Councils in Victoria have an opportunity to submit Resolutions to be considered by all present and authorised to vote. At these meetings updates are provide by the MAV on industry issues and the programs conducted by the MAV. The October Meeting is an Annual Meeting where the Annual Report, Financial Report, Chairs and CEO Reports are submitted for endorsement.

Alternative Options

The options available to Council are to appoint a different Councillor to attend the meeting or have no Councillor appointed. As Council have Resolutions at the meeting to be moved it is essential Council has a representative at this meeting.
