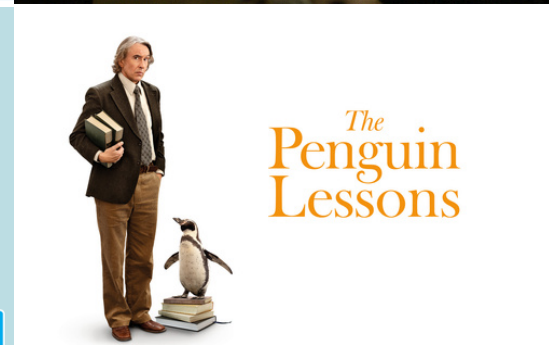
THE PENGUIN LESSONS
