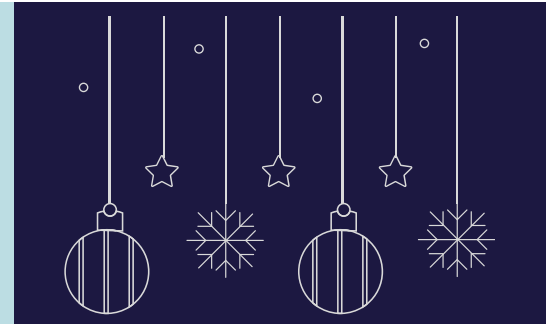


CHRISTMAS CLOSURE
