#### 7.1.1 Determination of Mayoral and Deputy Mayoral Term of Office

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Section 25 of the *Local Government Act 2020* provides that at a meeting of the Council that is open to the public, the Councillors must elect a Councillor to be the Mayor of the Council and must be determined by resolution of Council whether the Mayor is to be elected for a one year or two-year term.

#### **MOTION**

- 1. That Council determines the Mayor be elected for a term of one (1) year
- 2. That Council determined that a Deputy Mayor will be elected for a period of one (1) year, should Councillors chose to establish the office of Deputy Mayor.

#### 7.1.2 Election of the Mayor

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Under section (12) of Strathbogie Shire Council's Governance Rules, the Chief Executive Officer must facilitate the election of the Mayor in accordance with the provisions of the *Local Government Act 2020* (section 25(3)(a) and (b).

The role and functions of the Mayor are set out in Section (18) of the *Local Government Act* 2020 and include:

- the holder of this office is the chair at Council meetings
- is the leader of the councillors
- acts as the principal spokesperson for Council
- and carries out civic and ceremonial duties on behalf of Council.

The Chief Executive Officer called for nominations for the position of Mayor

- Councillor Vicki Halsall nominated Councillor Scott Jeffery
- Councillor Scott Jeffery accepted the nomination

As no further nominations were received, Councillor Scott Jeffery was duly elected Mayor for a period of one year.

Mayor Councillor Scott Jeffery thanked his fellow Councillors, saying he was honoured to be elected Mayor.

The Mayor, Councillor Scott Jeffery took the chair for the remainder of the meeting.

#### 7.1.3 Election of the Deputy Mayor

**RESPONSIBLE DIRECTOR** Director People and Governance

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Following an election, Councillors elect the Mayor from amongst themselves and may chose to elect a Deputy Mayor.

If a Council chooses to establish an office of Deputy Mayor, the Deputy Mayor must be elected by an absolute majority of Councillors at a meeting that is open to the public.

Where a Council has established an office of Deputy Mayor, Deputy Mayors must perform the role of the Mayor, and may exercise the Mayoral powers, in any of the following circumstances:

- when the Mayor is unable for any reason to attend a Council meeting, or part of a Council meeting
- when the Mayor is incapable of performing the duties of the office of Mayor for any reason, including illness
- · when the office of Mayor is vacant.

The Chair called for nominations for the position of Deputy Mayor.

- Councillor Greg Carlson nominated Councillor Claire Ewart-Kennedy
- Councillor Claire Ewart-Kennedy accepted the nomination
- Councillor Vicki Halsall self-nominated

As no further nominations were received, Mayor Scott Jeffery called for a vote by show of hands, in the order the nominations were received.

Councillor Claire Ewart-Kennedy, having received a majority of the votes, was elected Deputy Mayor for a period of one year.

Deputy Mayor Councillor Ewart-Kennedy thanked Councillors on her election and provided a "year in review", following from her term as Mayor.

#### 7.1.4 Provision of Mayoral Motor Vehicle

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Council has previously determined that a vehicle would be provided for use by the Mayor. The offer of the provision of a vehicle is at the discretion of the elected Mayor.

Council may also determine whether the Mayor sacrifices an amount for the additional cost of having full private use of the mayoral vehicle.

#### **MOTION**

#### **That Council:**

- 1. Determine that a motor vehicle be made available for the Mayor with full private use
- 2. Determine the monthly contribution to the upkeep of that vehicle to be deducted from the Mayor's allowance, at \$235 per calendar month for the use of the vehicle.
