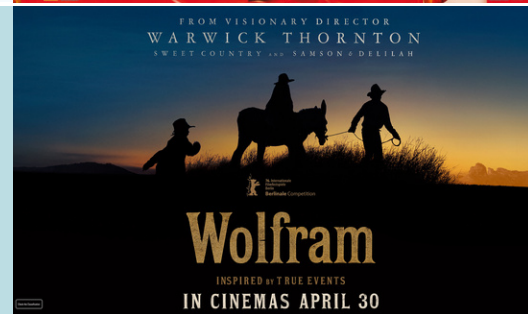

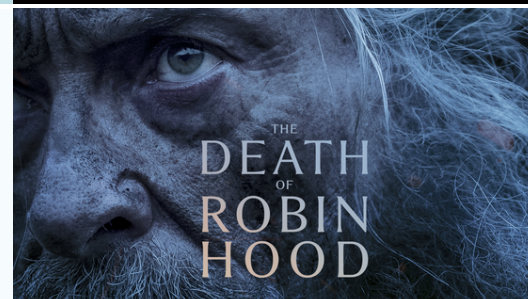
The Death of Robin Hood
